

### Consent form: Clinical photography and videography

At Penn Farm Podiatry, we sometimes take photographs and videos of our patients. Generally these are uploaded directly into one of our patient management systems, using a mobile phone, iPad, or secure wireless camera. For video appointments, screenshots of the screen may be taken and copied into your file.

There are several reasons for taking photographs and videos in this clinic. These might be:

1. A simple low-tech method of scanning documents into your computerised clinical notes.
2. An additional way to record information about you in your clinical notes.
3. To share with other health professionals either to seek advice or to provide education. The photograph or video would be anonymised but accompanying information may include information such as age, medications and medical history.
4. For health promotion activities, for example, talks to diabetes groups about foot care.
5. For marketing purposes, including on social media or the website. The photograph or video would be anonymised and include only very minimal accompanying information.
